Where do I Live?

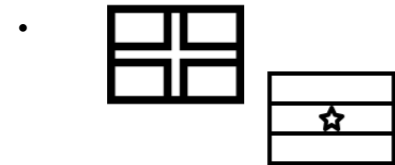
- Use of map skills to explore our local area around school

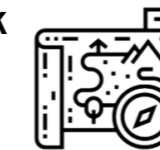


What a Wonderful World
